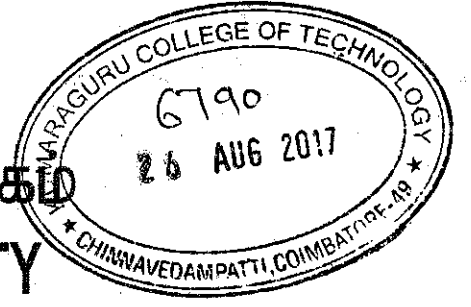

I am, by direction, to inform you that all arrear candidates of B.L/B.E /M.E/ B.Tech /
M.Tech/ MBA/ MCA/ B.Sc / M.Sc. Applied Sciences, M.Sc. Software Engineering, etc. degree
course(s) of FT/PT (irrespective of the year of admission - i.e. registered in Bharathiar
University) are permitted to complete their arrear subjects during November/December 2017,
April/May2018, November/December 2018 and April/May 2019 examinations with the same
syllabus. Further, it is informed that these are last chances for the arrear candidates and no
further extension will be given to them after the April/May 2019 examinations.

Further, it is informed that the Principals of Engineering colleges are requested to instruct
and obtain from the candidates while forwarding arrear examination application, an undertaking
to the effect that the engineering students are hereby permitted to appear for their arrear subjects
from **November/December 2017 to April/May 2019 University examinations** with the same
syllabus subject to the conditions that the candidates should submit an undertaking that they
should complete their arrear subjects within November 2017 to May 2019 University
examinations and they seek no further extension in this regard.

Futher, the Principals of Engineering Colleges and the Controller of Examinations
(Autonomous Engineering Colleges) and Controller of Examinations of Bharathiar University
are requested to give wide publicity to this to the extent possible so as to enable the arrear
students to make use of these opportunities and to avoid new set of students seeking extension
every year.

It is requested that the same may be brought to the notice of the staff and students
concerned.
