



B.E/ B.Tech Admissions

The B.E./B.Tech courses are the flagships programs at KCT. There are currently fourteen B.E./B.Tech programs offered at KCT and another B.Tech program is being introduced from the academic year 2020-21. The UG programs are affiliated to Anna University and the admissions guidelines laid down by the University and also the process defined by Directorate of Technical Education, Tamil Nadu is being followed.

UG Programs

Out of the total seats, 65% are filled up through single window counselling and the remaining 35% seats are filled by the management following the guidelines of DoTE and also by the consortium.

Scholarships

KCT offers the following scholarships for various categories based on merit.

Category - Cut-Off Marks

First Year Students admitted through Single Window counselling with highest Cut-Off in each program would be given Tuition Fee waiver during the first year, subject to a minimum Cut-Off of 190 / 200. Number of Scholarships in each programs depend on the number of divisions in each program. There will be one Scholarship for every division.

Centum Score

All First year students admitted through Single Window Counselling with Centum in Maths would be given Tuition Fee waiver during the first year.

Rural students

Toppers from Rural Schools admitted through Single Window Counselling would be offered Tuition Fee waiver during the first year subject to a minimum Cut-Off of 180 / 200. The students should submit a certificate from the Head Master of the school to confirm his rank.

Other State Students

Top TEN rank holders of any State or CBSE at the Plus Two or equivalent level would be offered Tuition Fee waiver in the 1st year and also Hostel Fee waiver. These students would be admitted under Management Quota.

Sports Scholarships

Awarded to students with an outstanding record in sports. Typically, students who have participated in National and International level competitions conducted by accredited Sports Boards are eligible for these scholarships.

These students would be admitted under Management Quota.

Scholarship for Physically Challenged, Transgender etc are special scholarships. They can contact the College office for more details.

Note: The scholarship would continue to senior students subject to the students maintaining a minimum CGPA of 8.50.

Sports

The sports person's proficient in the under mentioned sports / games only are eligible to apply under this category:

Sports / Games

Athletics, Badminton, Basket ball, Chess, Cricket, Squash, Table Tennis, Tennis, Football

Applicants have to produce the following documentary proof at the time of application

The sports person's proficient in the under mentioned sports / games only are eligible to apply under this category:

Category	Level of participation
Form - I	For representing the country (India) in the International Competitions recognized by Indian Olympic Association
Form - II	For representing the State in a national competition organized by recognized national Association in India affiliated to Sports Authority of India / Indian Olympic Association.
Form - IV	For representing the state school team in the National School Games Competition organized by School Games Federation of India (SGFI).
