## **Observations:**

# Academics

- The academic calendar of the college is prepared well in advance to facilitate effective planning and implementation.
- The college conducted a Faculty development programme to encourage the faculty to come out with innovative teaching pedagogy and research.
- To develop and enhance critical thinking skills, analytical abilities Project based learning –
   Engineering Clinic introduced to students.

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- Choice based elective courses have been offered in the name of FCLF- 47 courses offered in odd semester and 64 courses were offered in even semester under 4 categories(Science, Engineering and Technology, Management, Humanities and Social Sciences, Career Enhancement and skill development)
- Human excellence course as a one credit/mandatory course to enlighten the students on the rich heritage and culture of our nation and its ethical values.

## Teaching, learning and evaluation

- Faculty members are using ICT tools like Google classroom, Edmodo, Moodle etc.
- FDP- More than 90% of the faculty attended FDP.
- NPTEL Course- 464 (96 faculty & 368 students) completed NPTEL course during 2018-19.
- Course files were properly maintained by the faculty and was checked by the HoDs.
- Dummy numbering system and OMR based evaluation for End Semester Examinations are being followed. Revaluation, Conduct of post audit of end semester Question paper and external audit on evaluation of answer scripts are regularly carried out.

#### Research

- 511 research articles were published by faculty in Scopus indexed Journals during the AY 2018 – 2019.
- Research grant worth Rs.241.76 lakhs received from external agencies during the academic year.
- Proto semester- innovation engineers- One of the best practice to nurture innovation among Engineers.
- Research centres for students- Garage, KCIRI, Re, IQube, FORGE.
- Revenue generated through Consultancy needs to be documented in one place.

## Infrastructure and learning resources

- Adequate number of books and journals in Library. The compilation in the library is extensive owning 67598 titles and 107534 volumes and has a subscription to 186 print journals, 8829 online international journals and 59 magazines for scholarly communication.
- Automation of admission process, attendance entry.
- Good Infrastructure facility, sports facility, Gym.

### Student support and progression

- Clubs and Activities: Various clubs are functioning and lot of students got involved.
- In sports, overall Champion in the Anna University Zone XI Sports & Games for 6 consecutive years.

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- Management provides financial support to 73 students around 44.04 lakhs and sponsors
   Mahatma Gandhi Meritorious Scholarship to 1052 students of worth Rs1,04,30,000.
- Mentor-mentee system is followed.
- Office of Student Affairs (OSA) is functioning for the welfare of the students
- 705 students were placed out of 1021 registered students.
